Tournament Location: University of Winnipeg : Riddell Hall

Accommodations: Each visiting province will be provided three night accommodations in residence at either Booth College or U of W dorms. There are only a limited number of double rooms. These will be allotted to teams with Parents traveling with very young children (Grades 1-3) all other rooms are singles. Teams are booked for May 22nd, 23rd & 24th.

Visitors desiring further accommodation should be advised that the residence will be available on a limited basis two days before and two days after the 22nd and 24th, respectively. For those who would like or for those looking for hotel accommodations, we have made special arrangements with the Holiday Inn (one block south of the University) Please call them directly and note that you are with the Chess Challenge. Special Chess Rates here are: \$79.00 per room per night.

Airport Arrivals & Departures: We will arrange a bus pick-up and drop-off for each visiting province, getting you to & from the tournament site. Please provide me with your exact arrival and departure dates, flight numbers and times as soon as possible.

Meals: We will provide a hot buffet breakfast for players & coaches on Sunday, May 23rd & Monday, May 24th. at Booth College.
Family members and other visitors wishing to avail themselves of the breakfast can order tickets in advance at a cost of \$6 each tax included.
A hot lunch (three choices of meal / desert / salad bar / pasta bar) will be serve on Sunday, May 23rd & Monday, May 24th at the College cafeteria for those who pay in advance. The price is \$10 tax included.

2004 CANADIAN CHESS CHALLENGE INFORMATION

Each province participating in the 2003 Canadian Chess Challenge, May 23rd & 24th at the University of Winnipeg, Winnipeg Manitoba. will be provided - free of charge for a three-night stay - with the following accommodations in residence;

- three double rooms (each room contains two single beds), plus
- ten single rooms (with a single bed).

Each team is tentatively scheduled to stay on the nights of May 22nd, 23rd, & 24th. If your team wishes to change the days you plan to stay, please contact me at the phone number or e-mail listed below. Should you wish to reserve additional accommodations for parents, additional team personnel, etc, those accommodations will be at the expense of the visiting team or family members making the reservation. The rates are as follows:

- Single room: Students \$12; Adult \$25 (taxes included)

Each floor of Booth College has washroom & shower facilities. There is no daily maid service. Towels are not provided, although bedding, face cloths and soaps are in each room at Booth College. **PLEASE NOTE:** In the U of W residence there are no pillows or bed clothes, but each room has its own full bathroom. Teams scheduled to stay in that residence will be required to bring sleeping bags. If you don't want to do this get your reservations in early as Booth College will fill up quickly.

Pets are not allowed on either campus.

The facilities at this site are excellent. The residence, cafeteria and playing area are all within two blocks of each other and the University is right downtown, There is also a free shuttle bus service to Winnipeg's feature meeting place – The Forks (where there happens to be plenty of shops and restaurants.) All players & coaches will be provided a hot buffet breakfast on Sunday, May 23rd & Monday, May 24th. **Parents and other guests have to purchase their breakfast in advance.**

A buffet lunch (three courses) will be served on Sunday, May 23rd & Monday, May 24th for those who pay in advance.
