The tournament begins at 9 a.m. on Sunday, May 20th and should be over by 2:30 p.m. on Monday, May 21st. The Chess'n Math Association will cover up to a maximum of 3 nights lodging and breakfast for players (2 to a room - 2 single beds) as well as the team captain. If a player requires more than 3 nights lodging, please enclose a cheque for the additional nights at a cost of \$26 per night per person (double occupancy) or \$38 single occupancy. These prices include breakfast and taxes. Breakfasts will be served at the Laval University cafeteria in the Alphonse-Desjardins building, next to the Residences. Parents and others may also book lodging through us at the same rates. Players and Parents must pay in advance \$8 per meal if they wish to have lunch at the University cafeteria. The only organized supper will be the Banquet of Saturday evening at the cost of \$5 per player and \$15 for others (i.e. family, friends, visitors). The tournament will be played at the Laval University Sports Center (PEPS) which is a short walk from the residences. All the additional expenses (rooms and meals) will have to be paid in advance (at the latest on May 4, 2007).

Information sheet

PLACE AND SCHEDULE OF THE TOURNAMENT

The tournament will be played at the Laval University Sports Center (PEPS) which is a short walk from the residences. Tournament times: 9:00 am to 6:00 pm Sunday May 20, 2007 & 9:00 am and 2 pm Monday May 21, 2007.

AIRPORT ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

We will arrange a bus pick up and drop-off for each visiting province, getting to and from the tournament as of Friday May 18, 2007 with Tuesday May 22, 2007 being the last day this service will be offered.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Each visiting province will be provided three nights accommodations at the Residences of Laval University. Reserved for each delegation are 6 double rooms, plus a single rooms for team captain. Family members wishing to stay at the residence will require to pay \$26 (taxes included) each based on double accommodations or \$38 (taxes included) each based on single accommodation. All reservations of lodging must be made by May 4, 2007 and paid in advance. Those that are not paid in advance may find themselves searching for alternate lodging at their own expense. Each room comes equipped with a single bed, a sink, a dresser, a wardrobe, a desk and an armchair. A telephone is also included with local calls free. Long distance calls can be made with a calling Card. Washrooms with shower stalls are located on each floor, and bathrooms are available in all residences. On arrival, people will have to present themselves to the tournament organizer at the Alphonse-Marie-Parent building in order to receive their room keys and meal coupons. Check-out time is 11 A.M. Chaperones should review the rooms to ensure that all personal items have been removed, be sure that the room doors are closed and locked.

MEALS

Breakfasts are included in the price of the rooms. For the other meals you must order coupons in advance and pay them at the same time as your room. May 4, 2007 is your deadline to get the coupons. You will have to pay \$8 (taxes included) per person for lunches of Saturday May 19, Sunday May 20 and Monday May 21, 2007, and 5\$ per player (\$15 for others) for the banquet of Saturday evening. Breakfasts and lunches will be served at the cafeteria of Alphonse-Desjardins building, the banquet at the «Grand Salon» of the same building.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

A speed chess tournament (Blitz) is organized for the players at 2:00 p.m. Saturday May 19, 2007 (place to be confirmed) with a pre-registration cost of \$10 (\$15 on site). Two guided tours of Quebec city are available Saturday May 19, 2007 (10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.) at the cost of \$15 (taxes included) by person.

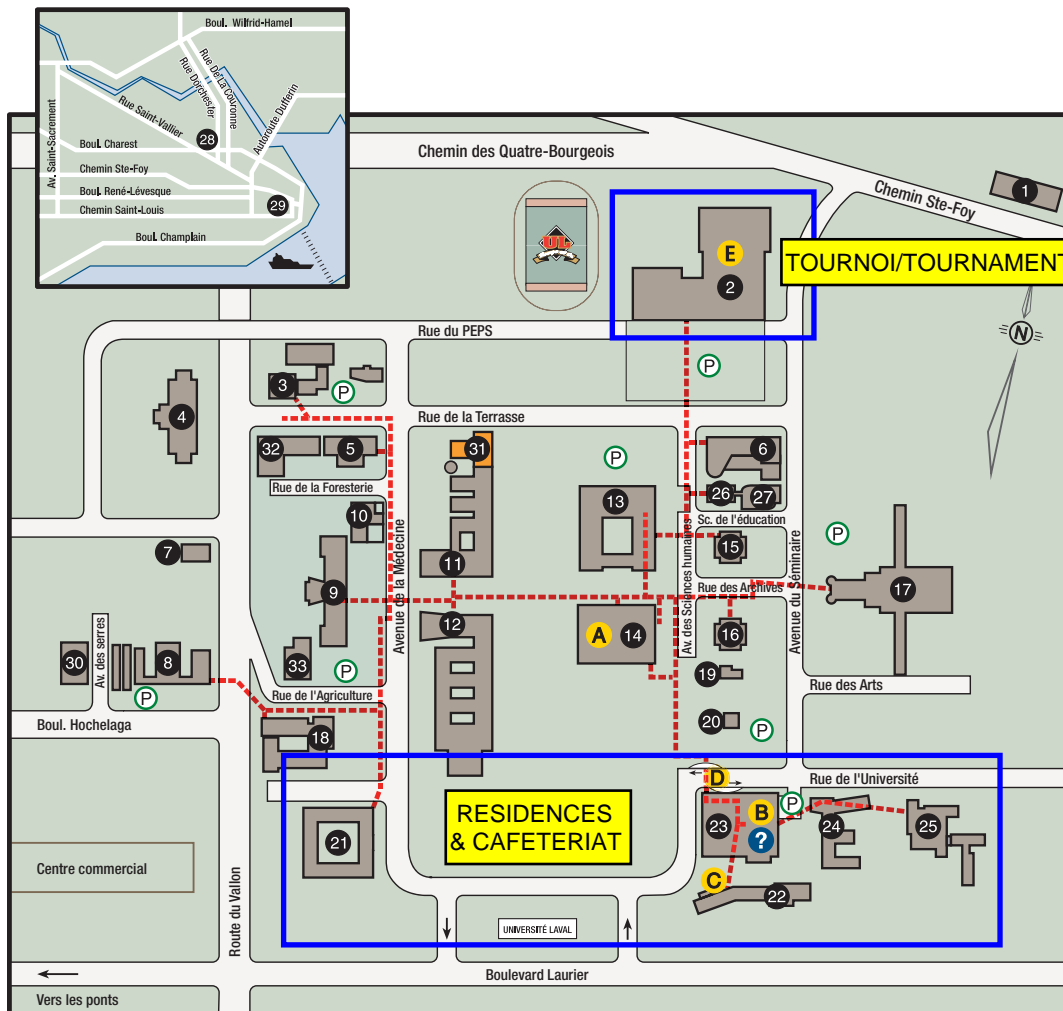
- Team contact person including phone number, e-mail and fax number;
