LOCATION AND SCHEDULE OF THE TOURNAMENT

The tournament will be held at the University of Regina. The tournament will take place in the Student Union's Multipurpose Room, located in the Dr. William Riddell Centre.

The tournament will run from 8:55 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Sunday, May 22 & 9:00 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday, May 23. The tournament room is a 5 min walk from the University Residence and a 25 min walk from the Executive Royal Hotel.

ACCOMMODATIONS

University of Regina Residences

The U of R Residence is an all-new facility. Most rooms are organized in 4 bedroom apartments with two bathrooms, a sitting area and a kitchen. Each bedroom can sleep up to three people (one single bed and a bunk bed). Cost for a bedroom is based on occupancy. Please note that all players must pay for their rooms, however, if you have an additional child under the age of 12 who is staying with an adult, they can stay for free. Please note that room rates do not include any meals.

Executive Royal Hotel - 4025 Albert Street South

We have reserved a limited number of rooms; one queen bed per room, at the rate of \$119 per night (not including tax). This hotel is approximately a 25 min walk from the playing room. There is also a bus that runs from close by to the university, but the schedule is limited on Sunday and Monday. To book at this rate, please call 306-586-6755 prior to April 15th.

A Welcome Banquet is organized Saturday May 21 at 6:00 pm at University of Regina, exact location to be announced. Pre-registration cost is \$15 for Provincial Champions and \$20 for all others (surcharge of \$5 on site, if places are available).

University of Regina Food Services is located in the Dr. William Riddell Centre. Meals are pay as you go. There are also several food establishments a short 10 min walk from the university.

OTHER CHESS ACTIVITIES

A speed chess tournament (Blitz) is organized for the players at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 21 (location to be confirmed) with a pre-registration cost of \$10 (\$15 on site).

Bughouse (double blitz – 5 rounds) will take place following the awards ceremony on Monday, May 23 with a cost of \$5 (\$10 on site).

Medals will be given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.

Both Blitz and Bughouse are open events, parents, friends and the members of the public are welcome to play.

Each suite has 4 bedrooms and 2 full bathrooms. The suites are arranged such that 2 bedrooms are at one end with one of the baths and the other 2 bedrooms are at the other end with the second bathroom. In between are a sitting area and a kitchen area. The kitchen will not have any dishes but there is a microwave and a fridge.

Charges are according to occupancy rate for each bedroom. You can book an entire apartment for 4 x the single rate **as long as** only 4 people are staying in that apartment.

For players traveling without parents, it will be an excellent cost savings to share a double or triple room with other players. Please indicate who is sharing with whom and organize with your provincial coordinator how to split the cost (e.g. if 2 players are sharing a room they will each pay \$41.80).

We will attempt to book provincial teams in the same suites as much as possible. If you have special requests, please write them below and we will do our best to accommodate them.
